Shenzhen Happy Valley 深圳欢乐谷



Covering an area of 350,000 square meters, the park boasts large quantities of breathtaking and exciting amusements to satisfy anyone's desire for modern entertainment. The park is composed of nine areas with different themes. They are Spanish Square, Cartoon City, Mt Adventure, Gold Mine Town, Shangri-la Woods, Sunshine Beach, Typhoon Bay, Playa Maya Water Park and Happy Times. The park offers nearly 100 exciting games for adults and children. Every day, there are excellent performances in different styles, such as magic, acrobatics and extreme sports.

Shenzhen Museum

Shenzhen Museum is a unit that works

for public good, not for it's own benefit. It spreads knowledge and carries out patriotic education wholeheartedly. As a comprehensive museum, it has become an important cultural facility of Shenzhen, giving full play to cultural relics collection, education and scientific research. There are more than 20,000 cultural relics, such as paleobiological fossils dating from 100 million years ago, ancient artifacts and art treasures. These show 5,000 years of Chinese civilization and important historical materials about modern and contemporary Shenzhen. These precious cultural relics are the important martical foundation of Shenzhen Museum.

The OCT Art & Design Gallery

The first art museum that focuses on fashionable design — the OCT Art & Design Gallery - was officially opened on Sept 1, 2008, in OCT. It is adjacent to He Xiangning Art Museum, Shenzhen OCT Intercontinental Hotel, as well as three cultural tourism scenic spots -Splendid China, the China Folk Culture

Village and Window of the World. It covers many design fields, such as graphic design, spatial design, product design, costume design, digital images and animation. It also will pay attention to contemporary art and multimedia activity, and actively explore and reflect the relationship between design and contemporary art. It covers 3,000 square meters, including a temperature-controlled area of 2,000 square meters and a temperature-controlled art gallery.

SHOPPING SPOTS

Dongmen Commercial Pedestrian Street

东门商业步行街

Also known as Dongmen Old Street, this area was established during the reign of Kangxi in the Qing Dynasty. Over the past 100 years, it has become the largest and busiest business district in Shenzhen. More than 4,000 stores of all sizes are crammed into Dongmen Commercial Pedestrian Street, including department stores, teahouses, Internet cafes, nightclubs, antique shops and art shops. The street's buildings are a wondrous blend of modernity and times past. After dusk, colorful neon lights set the street aglow as bustling tourists and locals scour the shops for the best bargains. Maoye Department Store Dongmen Shop, Tianhong Department Store Dongmen Shop, Friendship City, Sun Square and Baima Garments City are also on this street. Bus routes: 102, 113, 103, 203

Overseas Chinese Town

Overseas Chinese Town is a scenic spot in Nanshan district. It's near Huaqiaocheng Station on the Shenzhen Metro. It integrates traditional Chinese folk culture with world cultural essences. Theme parks include Splendid China, Chinese Folk Culture Village, Window of the World and Happy Valley. There are also many specialty food streets, a sound-system supermarket, a fitness center, a bar street, a Western fast food restaurant, a bookstore, a teahouse, a drugstore, a children's amusement park.

The Summer Tea House Jing Yi Tea House & Vegetarian Restaurant

This could be the best vegetarian restaurant in Shenzhen. It has been open for many years and has a loyal following. The menu contains many photos of the dishes so it is easier to order. Some dishes use soya beans to simulate the taste and texture of real meat and seafood. In accordance with Buddhist custom, it does not use any garlic or onions. The seventh floor is a traditional Chinese tea house-style, while the new eighth floor has a modern look with an outdoor terrace that's great for sipping tea.
