


& ceremony talk



OPENING CEREMONY

Performers dazzle the crowd with their high-flying act at Friday night's opening ceremony.

DOOR OF THE WORLD

The automatic steel door to the ceremony venue is 22.5 meters tall and 4 meters thick. It has two 55-meter-wide parts and is mounted on a 110-meter-long track. The door sets world records for its 430-ton weight.

FLAME TOWER

The tower is said to resemble a "mountain of books". Viewed from the front, it looks like 11 huge books piled up. It is about 26 m high, 2.2 m wide at the bottom and 7.8 m wide across the top. It weighs 243 tons.

LIGHTING THAT SHINES

A total of 16,000 digital devices, including 800 searchlights, 6,000 LED lights, 10 full-color lasers and 10 monochromatic lasers, were used in the opening ceremony.
