



## DELICACIES

### Sanhuang chicken of Longgang 龙岗三黄鸡



The sanhuang chickens of Longgang township in Longgang district are big and strong but have tender meat.

### Nan'ao abalone 南澳鲍鱼

"To eat seafood, go to Nan'ao," a local saying goes. Nan'ao township is the country's largest abalone breeding base. The abalone from Nan'ao has smooth, tender and nutritious meat. It has long been regarded as the best local seafood.

### Nan'ao sea urchin 南澳海胆

Nan'ao sea urchins boast a tenderness peculiar to South China. It is golden yellow. The meat is tender, silky and a little sour.



### Xixiang Jiwei shrimp 西乡基围虾

Jiwei-shrimp live in Xixiang in Bao'an district on the eastern inlet of the Pearl River. The shrimp are small and resemble a finger in shape. They are transparent from head to fin and have speckled shells. They are tender and delicious with a high protein content, comparable with Shajing oysters.

### Shajing oyster 沙井蚝

Oysters are the most famous specialty of Shenzhen, especially the Shajing variety, which comes from the mouth of the Pearl River where salt water and fresh water meet. The large, fleshy oysters contain rich nutrients, including protein, vitamins and dried starch. They are sometimes called "milk in the sea". Their iodine content is 200 times that of milk egg yolk.

## ATTRACTIONS

### Shenzhen Central Park 深圳中心公园

Shenzhen Central Park, which runs north-to-south, is located in the center of Shenzhen. The park adjoins Beacon Hill in the north and Huanggang Border in the south. It's known as a "fruit orchard green belt". Central Park takes "love and abide by nature" as its principle. The park uses plants' diversity and seasonal variations to shape its natural scenery. There are date palms from Canada; twin king coconuts; Kigelia pinnatas; elephant ear beans; sausage trees and rain trees. The periphery is covered with wooded

lawns and palm trees. The park's center is a central lawn surrounded by dense forest. With its fishing area in the artificial lake and a fitness center, the city has created a tranquil downtown location. There is no enclosure around Central Park. It is an oasis in the downtown and flanked by six roads. These are Shennan Avenue; West Zhenhua Road; Hongli Road; Huafu Road; Binhe Road; and Huanggang Road. It's also crossed by the Futian River. It's very convenient to get to the park with so many transport options.
